Using past exam papers

Using past exam papers is a valuable way of preparing and practicing for your exams. Review past papers and check out:

- number of sections and types of questions
- word length restrictions
- time allotment for the whole exam
- time allotment for each section (if any)
- the type of topics covered in the exams

Once you have an idea of what to expect, you might like to ask the course lecturer if you should expect any significant changes to your exam - such as the inclusion of 'short answer' instead of multiple choice questions.
